- I and my guests will be positive role models for the players by showing respect, courtesy and positive support for players on both teams, coaches, officials and other spectators at every event.
- I will respect the authority of the coach, umpire, and league or district officials during a game and will not question decisions during a game.
- I will follow the rules and regulations of Little League International and Canyon View Little League.
- As a parent I will help my child participate in practices and games. As a coach I will conduct practices and games so that all athletes have an opportunity to improve their skill level through active participation. As a player, I will do my best at every practice and game to improve my skills and help my teammates to do the same.
- I and my guests will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct. Remember, coaching from the stands is prohibited.
- I will not show hostility or violence towards other athletes, coaches or officials.
- I will not tolerate any form of abuse of children, whether physical, verbal, emotional, ethical or sexual and will immediately report any such abuse to the proper authorities.
- I recognize that Little League is a volunteer-run organization, and as a parent I will contribute my time to the best of my ability to enhance my child's experience.

The Board of Directors will review all infractions of the Code of Conduct. Depending on the seriousness or frequency, the board may assess additional disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the league.
